

Camp STIX Dress Code

To minimize any potential conflicts, please dress modestly. This may mean we dress differently than we would at home, so keep these guidelines in mind as you pack:

- Revealing clothing is unacceptable. Persons wearing offensive clothing will be asked to change or cover up.
- Campers and camp personnel will exercise appropriate modesty when changing their clothes and change in a private area.
- Cover-up attire and footwear should be worn to and from the water areas.
- Proper footwear is required at all times -- no bare feet outside water areas (use athletic shoes for activities).
- Explicit attire (reference to drugs, alcohol, profanity and sex) are unacceptable.
- Proper personal hygiene is required- PLEASE.
- Please keep covered all explicit tattoos and piercings.

If you have to question what you are wearing, it may not be appropriate for camp. Feel free to ask the Camp Director if you have questions. If adherence to the dress code is not followed, you may be asked to leave. There really is no fashion statement to be made at camp so relax and have fun.
